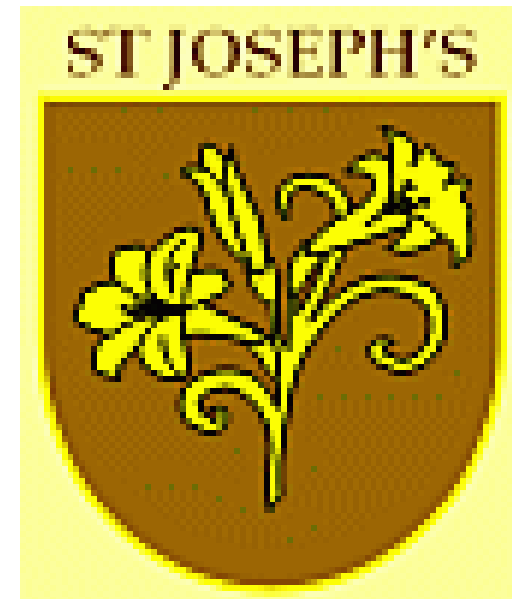

The School Promise

Homework

Foundation Stage 20-30mins Reading, phonic & number work

Years 1 and 2 1 hour a week (reading, spelling, other literacy work and number work)

Years 3 and 4 1½ hours a week (literacy and numeracy work, and occasional assignments in other subjects)

Years 5 and 6 30 minutes a day (regular weekly schedule with continued emphasis on literacy and numeracy, but also ranging widely over the curriculum)

The Parent Promise

We recognise our responsibility as parents or guardians to be the primary educators of our children. We will work in partnership with us, to enrich our children's lives.

For our part we will try to:

- encourage my child to show kindness and consideration to others.
- support the Christian values of the school community
- talk to my child about their experiences in school and encourage them to do their best
- ensure my child attends school regularly, on time and suitably equipped and provide an explanation for any absences
- attend parent evenings and information meetings and support school events
- support the Catholic community and school governors in their responsibilities for maintaining the school buildings in good repair
- talk to the school if my child is worried about attending school or if something happens to affect my child's learning
- work with the school to try and make sure that my child behaves well
- wear the correct school uniform
- read every night with my child and sign the reading record
- ensure my child completes their homework, every week
