### **Snow Procedures**

It may snow at some point this term. Therefore, I would just like to remind all parents of the bad weather procedures.

If in the unlikely event the school needs to be closed, please follow any of the procedures listed below:

1. Firstly, a text message will be sent to you via Parent Mail. Please ensure the school office has your correct mobile number.
2. Check the school website after 7.35a.m. to see if the school is closed or opening at a later time [www.stjosephs775.herts.sch.uk](http://www.stjosephs775.herts.sch.uk).
3. Check our twitter feed @stjosephs775
4. Contact the school office after 7.45a.m. and listen to the answer machine message.
5. Listen to the local radio stations which will provide updated information on school closures.
6. Register with Everbridge School Closure Notification System following at the following website: <https://member.everbridge.net/index/892807736725489>

This link will direct you to the 'Sign Up' page. Click on the 'sign up' button located at the top right hand side of the page on the grey strip. From there, follow the instructions. It should take no more than five minutes to register. You can have two devices added so you may want to include the mobile number and email address of a spouse or grandparent. They too would then receive any messages in relation to our school's closure. Alternatively, other people can register themselves separately.

If you have children at more than one school, you can register for those schools too in a single registration process by selecting all schools at which you have children.

Please note: this messaging system only applies to notifications of school emergency closure and does not in any way replace our usual Parentmail messaging system. If you require any assistance in signing up, please contact us.

### **Attendance**

Attending and taking part in learning is fundamental to ensuring that our children become successful learners, confident individuals, effective contributors and it is an important life skill.

Parents and carers are by far the most important influence on children's lives and learning and it is parents and carers who are responsible for making sure their child is educated.

The responsibility for good attendance is shared between school, parents and pupils but it is imperative that we work together to deal with any problems that may lead to non-attendance.

There will be times when your child will be absent from school because of genuine ill health. However, all absences can be detrimental to children's progress. Hence, if your child's level of attendance deteriorates, we will contact you to see if there is any way we can support you to help improve your child's attendance.

When the reason provided for an absence is deemed not to be acceptable then the absence may be recorded as unauthorised. Please note, if a pupil has at least 15 sessions (half day= 1 session) unauthorised absence in a term (including unauthorised holidays), a Penalty Notice may be issued. The Penalty is £60 (per parent/per child). All holidays during term time are not permitted and will be classed as unauthorised. Thank you for your co-operation and support.

If you would like your child to be picked up from school by another person, please inform the school office or class teacher by 2.00p.m.

The school disco will be on Friday 30<sup>th</sup> November. Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1 disco starts at 3.15p.m. – 4.30p.m. Key Stage 2 disco starts 5p.m. – 6.30p.m. £5 per child.
